**Old (& Continuing) Business:****A. 5K-** “Spring 4 A Cause/ A Run for ReAnna” 5K held on March 19, 2016 @ The Riverview Club.

- Klein states race was a success; “great race” “happy runners”
- Plenty of volunteers; Boys Baseball was rewarded for their “awesome participation” with a pizza party.
- Klein would like to reserve the Riverview Club next year for a pancake breakfast after the race; awards to be presented at that time.
- Race raised nearly \$11k dollars to date (after expenses paid); Klein anticipates additional funds to be donated in the next few weeks from businesses/individuals who continue to ask him how they can contribute.
- Board approved \$1k donation to The Betty Griffin House; the dollar amount of future races are not established by this donation, however contingent upon amount raised after expenses.

**B. Signage- Sponsors for next year 2016/2017**

- Sapp & Money have been working on forms/updates; will have ready for distribution within the next 2-3 weeks. As always, previous sponsors have “Right of First Refusal”; after deadline, sponsors are open to any student to approach.
  - Prices will likely remain the same as 2015/2016
  - Pyramid tents will be available for sidelines (not just endzone) in an effort to de-clutter that area and also open up more spots (last year, tent sales were capped at 12).
