 - Bozard Ford is the title sponsor of this event; Klein has leads with other organizations as well
 - Klein **NEEDS VOLUNTEERS:** Money and Ward have agreed to help with seeking sponsors
 - Klein would like to meet a goal of \$10k raised

 - Klein estimates approx. 600 runners
 - Focus of run will be for Domestic Violence Awareness
 - Proceeds will provide a scholarship (or several) to athletes pursuing a nursing education; Klein would also like to get Betty Griffin House involved and provide some funds to them as well
 - Klein reports Taylor has applied for the proper permits; they are ahead of schedule on the planning
 - Money suggested reaching out to the Nursing Academy (at PMHS) for help as well
- **Bozard Ford/Lincoln “Driven to Give” event-** check has been received from this event during Homecoming game- October 23, 2015. We raised \$5,700 which will be credited to the General Account.

New Business:

- **Updates from Dr. Carmichael**
