Old (& Continuing) Business / New Business:

A. Introduce New Board

Roger Williams will be our new President; Maudena Sims will be our new Treasurer. Both will
assume their roles/responsibilities as of July 1, 2016 as that is start of a new fiscal year according
to SJCSD.

B. Signage-Sponsors for next year 2016/2017

- O Sponsor Packages continuing to be sold; sponsor deadline for guaranteed signage by first football game is August 1st. Signs can continue to be sold however!
 - Tisha Money will continue to handle sponsor packages/ signage coordination for the 2016/2017 school year as not to bombard Roger Williams with this tedious task.
 - Most signage from last year will need to be re-purchased as the boards took a beating since they were not backed by another sign facing SR206 (due to county regs). It is recommended to turn the damaged signs to the blank side (so the white faces SR 206) and have them back the new signs this year to attempt to eliminate some damage.
 - Sponsor list (thus far) was passed around to see where we stand; list needs to be updated and distributed via email to coaches. *Tisha
 - ALL BUSINESSES (except those who have already committed) ARE OPEN TO ANY PLAYER TO APPROACH NOW. Deadline for renewal commitment to previous years' player was <u>June 1</u>, 2016.

C. Orientation Dates-

- o Monday, July 25th: FRESHMAN 8a-1p
 - We will need volunteers to assist with selling PE uniforms (at least 6 needed).
 - Boosters will have 2hr window to sell uniforms; will set up in same location outside of gymnasium in hallway blocking glass doors.
 - Cash and credit are accepted; NO CHECKS. (Money and Edwards have credit app on their mobile devices)
 - Dr. Carmichael would like to distribute polyester drawstring backpack/slings to all
 incoming Freshmen. This would be school funds, not Boosters. *Edwards to get price
 from spirit wear vendor. (350 needed)

- o Friday, July 29th: SOPHOMORES 9a-11a

D. Other Items (not on agenda)-

- o Carmichael introduced new Assistant Principal: Mrs. Jessica Balla
 - Mrs. Balla comes from Nease High School where she was the Asst. Principal
- o Sapp requests funds for new Cheer uniforms; cost is \$6,000. Half requested.
 - No form or 2nd estimate submitted prior to meeting as previously requested.
 - Klein motioned to approve; Taylor 2nd; all in favor.
- Sapp also mentioned a need for sand for fields. According to his calculations, the sand is nearly \$600 per load and he will need at least 5 loads; total is \$3,000.
 - Klein motioned to approve; Ward 2nd.
 - Maudena Sims will look at cost/grade of sand she can get and see if there is money to be saved here before a purchase is made. Her business has the contract with SJCSD to provide dirt/sand as needed for an already negotiated price. This could be a huge money saver!
- o 5K Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the school of recipient's attendance. Any other information regarding this should be directed to Klein or Taylor.
- o Final profit total for Grad Seating was \$11,137
 - Funds credited to AD account
 - It is suggested to combine AD and General accounts; will discuss at next meeting.
- Final profit total for Spring Golf Tournament? No figure available at this time. *Lands/ Sims to provide calculation at July meeting.
